**Check out...**

*"Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path." Psalm 119:105*

When we learn verses and store them in our minds, the Holy Spirit will remind us of them in different situations and this can help us to make decisions that please God. We can also share these verses with others who might need to hear truth or be encouraged.
