So... what is a sermon?

It is where someone, usually an elder, teaches or preaches God's Word and explains what it means and how it applies to our lives.

What does that mean for us?

God wants us to know and understand His Word and then put it into practice.

Sermon notes help us to do this. When we listen to someone talking, we don't remember most of what we hear. However, when we write while we listen, we remember more.

Even better, if we go back over the notes, we remember even more!! The Holy Spirit can use this to speak to us and remind us of what He wants to say to us.

What next?

As you listen to the person preaching, write down the main Bible verses, important points that stand out to you and things that you don't understand. There will be time to ask questions and talk about this later.
